REBECCA MARTINEZ, County Clerk-Recorder & Registrar of Voters announced today that Vote by Mail Ballots for the November 2, 2010 Consolidated Statewide General Election will be mailed beginning October 4, 2010.

Voters are reminded to follow the instructions provided with the ballot and to use only a #2 pencil to mark choices on their vote by mail ballot. Sign the blue envelope where indicated, and affix proper postage to return the ballot by mail

In order for a ballot to be counted, it must be received by not later than 8pm on Election Day, either at the office of the County Clerk or at any Madera County polling place. **Postmarks are not acceptable.**
