VOTE BY MAIL - BALLOT REQUESTS:

For persons wishing to vote by mail at the June 3, 2014 Statewide Direct Primary Election, ballots will be issued between May 5, 2014 and May 27, 2014.

Any registered voter may apply for a Vote by Mail ballot and request permanent Vote by Mail status. Requests for vote by mail ballots may be submitted in writing (i.e. sample ballot application, letter from voter, or in person at the County Clerk's office) or by calling the County Clerk Elections Division.

After May 27th, voters must apply in person at the County Clerk's office.

The County Clerk's office is located at the County Government Center, First Floor, 200 W. 4th Street, Madera.
