**REBECCA MARTINEZ**, County Clerk-Recorder and Registrar of Voters announced today that in order to be eligible to vote in the June 3, 2014 Statewide Direct Primary Election, persons must register to vote by Monday, May 19, 2014.

In order to be eligible to register to vote, a person must be a United States Citizen, live in Madera County and be 18 years old on or before Election Day. Registered voters who have moved, changed their name, or wish to change their political party must re-register by May 19, 2014.

Voter registration cards are available at the County Clerk's office (call to request a card by mail or come in), local Post Offices, local Libraries, or register to vote online at [www.votemadera.com](http://www.votemadera.com) or [www.registertovote.ca.gov](http://www.registertovote.ca.gov).

The County Clerk's office will be open until 6pm on May 19, 2014 to accept voter registration cards.
