MADERA, CA. – Rebecca Martinez, County Clerk-Recorder, is advising that, pursuant to an order filed by Cecilia Massetti, County Superintendent of Schools, a special election will be held June 7, 2011 in the Bass Lake Joint Union School District to elect a Board member to fill the vacancy that exists due to the resignation of Beverly Scott, for the remainder of the full term that expires following the November 2014 general election.

Candidates for the position must reside in the Oakhurst/Mariposa area. The filing period opens on February 14, continuing Monday through Friday (with the exception of February 18, when the office will be closed due to a county furlough day, and a holiday on February 21), and concludes March 11, 2011.
