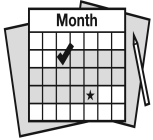


VOTER'S CHOICE ACT WORKSHOP

WHO?

The public is invited. Representatives from the Madera County Registrar of Voters' Office, Mi Familia Vota, Madera Votes, local transit agencies, and many more organizations will be on hand to answer questions, provide information about the upcoming election and help you plan to vote in the next election.



WHY?

This workshop is being held to help inform voters about the improvements that have been made to the voting process. This workshop will be conducted in both English and Spanish and the public is encouraged to attend.

WHY THE NEW IMPROVEMENTS?

The California Voter's Choice Act became law in 2016 to make voting more convenient and accessible.

- **Every Madera County registered voter** will be sent a ballot on May 7, 2018.
- You can return your ballot **by mail, in a ballot drop box or at a Vote Center.**
- **You can vote in person at any Madera County Vote Center.** Vote centers begin opening on May 26th, 2018 and will be open through Election Day, including weekends.
- **We are here to help you vote.** Assistance is available in Spanish and Punjabi and for voters with disabilities.
