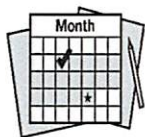


# VOTER'S CHOICE ACT WORKSHOP

## WHO?

The public is invited. Representatives from the Madera County Registrar of Voters' Office will be on hand to answer questions, provide information about the upcoming election and help you plan to vote in the next election. Spanish and Punjabi Translators will be in attendance to assist you.



## WHY?

This workshop is being held to help inform voters about the improvements that have been made to the voting process. This workshop will be conducted in English, Spanish and Punjabi. The public is welcome and encouraged to attend.

**The California Voter's Choice Act became law in 2016 to make voting more convenient and accessible.**

- **Every Madera County registered voter** will be sent a ballot on October 8th, 2018.
- You can return your ballot **by mail, in a ballot drop box or at a Vote Center.**
- **You can vote in person at any Madera County Vote Center.** Vote centers begin opening on October 27<sup>th</sup>, 2018 and will be open through Election Day, including weekends.
- **We are here to help you vote.** Assistance is available in Spanish, Punjabi and for voters with disabilities.
