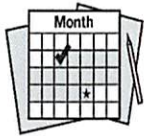


VOTER'S CHOICE ACT WORKSHOP

WHO?

The public is invited. Representatives from the Madera County Registrar of Voters' Office, Disability Rights California, Resources for Independence Central Valley and many more organizations will be on hand to answer questions, provide information about the upcoming election and help you plan to vote in the next election.



WHY?

This workshop is being held to focus on the accessibility aspects of the Voter's Choice Act. Information about accessible equipment, the Remote Accessible Vote by Mail System and the services available to those with disabilities will be available.

WHY THE NEW IMPROVEMENTS?

The California Voter's Choice Act became law in 2016 to make voting more convenient and accessible.

- **Every Madera County registered voter** will be sent a ballot on October 8th, 2018.
- You can return your ballot **by mail, in a ballot drop box or at a Vote Center.**
- **You can vote in person at any Madera County Vote Center.** Vote centers begin opening on October 27th, 2018 and will be open through Election Day, including weekends.
- **We are here to help you vote.** Election Officials will be in attendance to help you.
