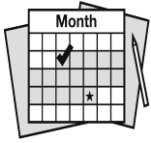


# VOTER'S CHOICE ACT WORKSHOPS

## WHY?

The workshops are being held to focus on the accessibility aspects of the Voter's Choice Act. During the first workshop election officials will focus on the many disability accessibility features available to voters. During the second workshop election officials will provide language accessibility information. Election officials fluent in Spanish and Punjabi will be on hand to answer questions and provide extensive information to the public.

**The Presidential Primary Election is QUICKLY approaching!**

- February 3<sup>rd</sup> - All registered voters will be mailed a vote by mail ballot
- February 4<sup>th</sup> - All Ballot Dropboxes Open
- February 22<sup>nd</sup> - Madera Central and Oakhurst Vote Centers Open
- February 29<sup>th</sup> - Five additional Vote Centers open in Madera, Chowchilla, Coarsegold and the Madera Ranchos.
- March 3<sup>rd</sup> - **THE LAST DAY TO VOTE – Don't wait! There will be long lines! Vote before the last day!**
