Period to submit Rebuttals to Arguments For or Against Measures

September 12, 2022 to October 25, 2022

Write-in Candidacy Period

Candidates for City offices are required to obtain nomination signatures from voters as part of their qualification to run for office. For more information, call the Elections Division. Pursuant to Elections Code Section 10515, if there is an insufficient number of nominees, the supervising authority shall make appointments.

The elections official shall make a copy of the materials submitted available for public examination in her office for a period of 10 calendar days immediately following the filing deadline for the submission of those documents. Any person may obtain a copy of the materials from the elections official. The elections official may charge a fee to any person obtaining a copy of the material. The fee may not exceed the actual cost incurred by the elections official in providing the copy.

Vote Centers will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on the day of the election. The boundaries of the voting precincts within the County, the location of the Vote Centers and the names of the officers selected to conduct the election shall be determined by the Registrar of Voters of Madera County.
