**NOTICE IS HERBY GIVEN** that the following measure will be voted on at the November 8, 2022, Consolidated General Election to be held in the County of Madera:

**County Measure T:** To keep local streets, highways, and infrastructure in good repair; fix potholes, pave/ maintain local streets; improve highway safety and 9-1-1 emergency vehicle access; retrofit older bridges/ overpasses; complete other transportation projects; and qualify for \$600,000,000 in State/ Federal matching funds, shall an ordinance be adopted continuing Madera County's voter- approved ½¢ sales tax without increasing the tax rate, renewing \$20,000,000 annually until ended by voters, with citizen oversight/ independent audits and all money staying local? **NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN** that 5:00 pm, on August 22, 2022, is hereby fixed as the final deadline for filing arguments in favor of, or against county measures, and said arguments cannot exceed three hundred (300) words in length. To be eligible for printing and distribution as provided by law, any such arguments must be received and filed with the Madera County Clerk-Recorder Elections Division no later than said date and time and must be accompanied by a Ballot Argument Signature Statement, signed, and dated by the author(s).

**NOTICE IS ALSO HERBY GIVEN** that if an argument in favor of and an argument against the measure is submitted, copies will be mailed to the respective authors in order that they may submit a rebuttal argument not to exceed two hundred fifty (250) words. Rebuttal arguments must be filed not later than 5:00 pm on September 2, 2022, and must also be accompanied by a Ballot Argument Signature Statement, signed, and dated by the author(s).

**NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN** forms for writing arguments and rebuttals may be obtained in person at the Madera County Clerk-Recorder Elections Division, 200 W. 4<sup>th</sup> Street, Madera, Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 am and 5:00 pm.
